- 1) The website has all of the information about Belmont Hills and Citrus Hills communities and a Password protected Resident list. Belmont2018
- 2) This is a Deed Restricted Community, meaning any changes to your lot or the exterior of your home, you must submit a Request for Change form to the ACC Committee for review and approval. The ACC Change Form is on the website under Resident Information.
- 3) Any fees or assessments are a lien against the property until paid.
- 4) Social Membership is mandatory for each residence, which allows you access and use any of the Citrus Hills facilities
- 5) The management of the Belmont Hills POA is under the control of Citrus Hills. the Board has five members, of which Belmont Hills residents have two of the five members (Glenn Khoury and Marve Stockert).
- 6) Gate access is either with a clicker, you can obtain it at the Activities Center or have your guest find your name on the call box, it will call you, you press 9 on your phone and the gate will open. You can also have your guest call and ask for the code. Let them know the code is, then they can enter the code and the gate will open.
